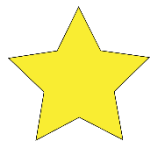
SPECIAL LETTER HOME

Tonight, your child has an individual note from their teacher with an adjective to remind them of one of the very special things about them. They are all SUPERSTARS!!



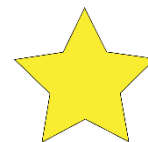
Hoopstarz Day with Kidz R Fit

You are all SUPERSTARS!!

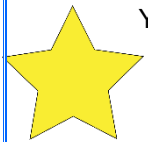


Football Tournament – Thursday 14th November – Spennymoor League, Brewery Fields
