Australian Bushfires and the Impact on the Wildlife Dress in Animal Print – Friday 24th January

Well done everyone, we managed to raise a fantastic £215.29 for the wildlife in Australia who have been affected by the bushfires. We will be donating £190.29 to the WWF Australia Bushfire Emergency Fund which will:

- Provide emergency fund to care for injured wildlife
- After the fires clear, help to restore homes for koalas and other wildlife, planting the first 10,000 trees urgently needed in koala habitats
- Support the response, recovery and restoration teams in any other way they can
- Help pressure governments to strengthen laws that prevent excessive tree clearing, before it's too late

We will also be donating £25 to become a koala protector. We will receive a koala protector certificate and over the coming months we will be sent an update on how

our donation aided the response, recovery and restoration of koalas and their habitats. A massive thank you to everyone who donated.
