PARENT GOVERNOR VACANCY

As a result of the federation between Etherley Lane Primary School and Etherley Lane Nursery, a single governing body will be created. Four parent governors will make up part of this governing body. Currently, we have four parent governors across the two schools who have expressed that they would like to be part of the new governing body. However, we need to give all parents the opportunity to express an interest in becoming a governor if they wish to. If you are interested in being considered for the role as a parent governor, please contact the school before Friday 1st July for a nomination form. Where the number of nominations is equal to, or fewer than the places available, no ballot will be necessary. Any remaining vacancies will be appointed by the Governing Body. Should a ballot be required each parent will be sent a voting form. When the process has been finalised school will inform the parent body via email. School and Governor Support Service will write formally to all nominees confirming the outcome of the ballot.
