We are so excited to be starting our after-school clubs again next week. You will have been notified by text message today about which club your child had secured a place for. The clubs are as follows:

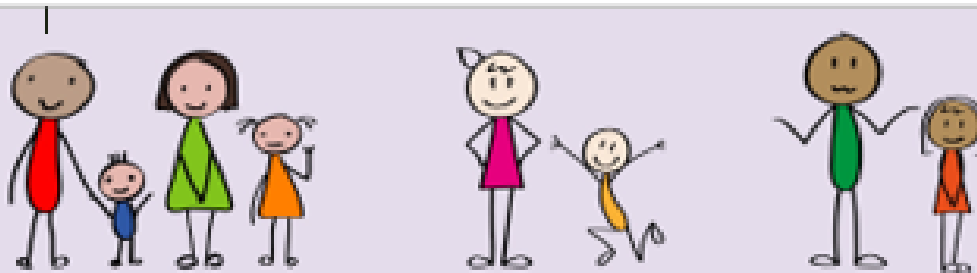
